England Netball's purpose is to lead a movement on and beyond the court and to uphold an unapologetic focus on women and girls whilst opening the game for new audiences to belong, flourish and soar. The Performance team aims to set new standards for netball, showcasing inspiring performances by outstanding players in international tournaments. It will do this through supporting the Roses to achieve recognition and respect as the world's best female sports team. It will grow a professional performance system and a talent pathway that reinvigorates the game, developing and supporting an unending supply of outstanding players.

Netball is a popular female sport in England and England Netball's Performances at the Commonwealth Games and World Cup play a huge part in the large participation numbers. The Roses and Future Roses groups are the top two tiers of our pathway and this is an exciting opportunity to work with both as we embark on the first year of a new cycle. It is a chance to work directly with players while also impacting on the wider SSSM strategy, working closely with the other members of the team.

The National Governing Body of England Netball is based at Loughborough University where the majority of training camps occur. The players attend camps August through to January with 2-3 competitive series throughout the International calendar year. Players are then based with their Superleague franchises Feb-June when our work becomes more remote or involves some UK travel.
