### ROLE SUMMARY

The UKSI and British Athletics have an exciting opportunity for a Full-time, Biomechanic Technician working as part of a multi-disciplinary team to create a world-class high-performance environment.

Working within the British Athletics Performance Support team and the UK Sports Institute technical interface you will help facilitate the day-to-day biomechanical capture of athletes to enhance and impact the performance of the British Athletics programme.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Deliver “front-line” biomechanical support for domestic and international competitions and training, including video/data capture and preparation, to enhance the coaching process for all Olympic programmes.
- Build and maintain effective working relationships with British Athletics practitioners, national UKSI biomechanics practitioners and local UKSI site staff.
- Monitor and help maintain relevant technical equipment and software.
- Work within the rules of the relevant governing body’s (eg. NGB, BOA, UK Sports Institute) Code of Conduct, standards and guidelines.
- Support performance projects through working collaboratively with UKSI core teams, and with external partners and/or UK Sport.
- Contribute to validity and reliability research across the UKSI biomechanics team and its high-performance centres.
- Work collaboratively within the UK Sports Institute, with external partners and UK Sport to meet the needs of performance and amplify the impact of biomechanics support.
- Contribute to knowledge development, aggregation and sharing across the organisation to support the development of world class biomechanical services and the high-performance system.
